

THE VENUE

Built in 1545 by Sir John Wentworth, Gosfield Hall is a Grade I listed country house set across ten acres of countryside in the heart of Essex county, where Vivien was born. In the past it played host to Queen Elizabeth I and her royal retinue, and was for several years the residence of the future King Louis XVIII and his wife, Marie Joséphine of Savoy. The address is Hall Drive, Gosfield, Halstead, Essex CO9 1SF.

TRAVEL

By Car: Access from the M11. Free parking is available on-site until 10.30am. Please follow signs directly to the house.

By Train: Regular services depart from London Liverpool Street to Braintree Freeport station. Gosfield Hall is a 15-minute taxi from the station.

By Air: The closest airport is Stanstead Airport, a 30-minute drive away.

ACCOMMODATION

Double and twin rooms are available in the house on a first-come-first-served basis at a rate of £200 per room. Alternative accommodation is available a short taxi ride away in Halstead (5-10min) and in Braintree (10-15min).

DRESS
