Who, being naughty in my sight, shall snuff it"

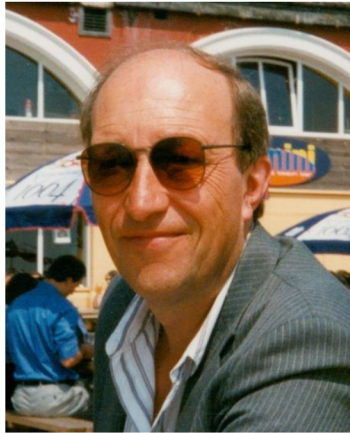
