This was the first of the signs given by Jesus - at Cana in Galilee.

Fr Peter: The Gospel of the Lord.

All: Praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ.

HOMILY

THE RITE OF MARRIAGE

After receiving the consent of the couple Fr Peter invites those present to praise God:
