Who has made all things well. [Refrain]

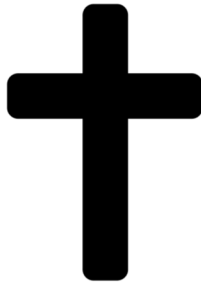
