or you can open your eyes and see all she's left.

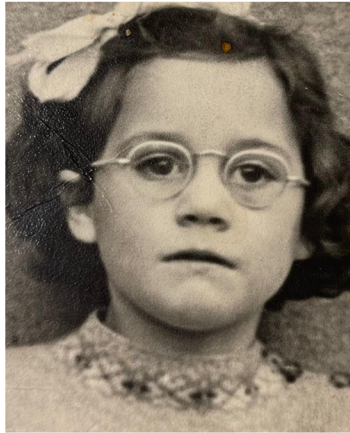
Your heart can be empty because you can't see her
