## **Music Choices**

### ***Bridal Entrance***

While Caity was growing up her Dad was involved, through the Dresden Trust, in the rebuilding of the Frauenkirche. This piece was the unofficial anthem of the project and was played majestically by Ludwig Güttler at the opening service. It evokes many of Caity's most special childhood memories, of family holidays in Dresden.

### ***A Mighty Fortress***

Known as the battle hymn of the Reformation, this hymn reminds us that God is our mighty protector and that we need never fear since He is with us. We want to live our married life in His strength and not our own.
