Dad had many a story to tell...here is a summary of his career and some highlights

After graduation, dad married mum in 1961. They met whilst dad was studying at Strathclyde University and mum was completing her nursing training. In Scotland dad worked with some of the steel companies. Projects included the hydro-electric scheme in Inverary, the

Loch Striven Oil Depot and the Clyde Tunnel Approach. Dad was a proud Member of the Institute of Civil Engineers and helped sponsor new students at Glasgow University.

In England, He worked with various engineering companies and ultimately for the Greater London Council (GLC). Whilst at Soil Mechanics, He did feasibility studies for the Chowilla Dam and the Perth Flyovers in Australia.

At WS Atkins, he worked on designs for flyovers for the southern end of the M1. Then, there was the famous Thames Flood Barrier, dad supervised 1000 drawings and was an integral part of that incredible feat of engineering. His last job was at the GLC where he was involved in Building Control. After taking early retirement he helped mum run the Warwick Guest House, where several tennis players stayed during Wimbledon, including Ken Rosewall.

Dad was also president of the Oxshott Scottish Society. After about four shots of whiskey and proposing various toasts, he was so inebriated he didn't know what he was saying, 'but the members were probably in no better state and I got a noisy appreciation.'
