Dulcie's Chocolate Cake

2 cups sugar
2 cups flour
3/4 cup cocoa powder
2 teaspoons bicarbonate of soda
1 teaspoon baking powder
1 teaspoon vanilla essence
2 eggs
1/2 cup oil
1 cup milk
1 cup boiling coffee
1/2 teaspoon salt

Mix all ingredients together & beat together. Place in ungreased cake pan. Bake at 180 degrees C (350 degrees F) for about 35 minutes. Sprinkle with icing sugar once cooled, or gently heat chocolate frosting & drizzle over the cake (for ultimate chocolatey goodness)
