HISTORY

Across the centuries, Neidpath Castle has been home to generations of the Fraser, Hay, and Douglas families. And for over 200 years, the estate has been privately owned by the Wemyss family. The true beauty of Neidpath is that very little has changed over the years. The rugged stone walls, hidden staircases, and beautiful views from the battlements would all be very familiar to its former residents.

Outside, the ancestral emblems are clear to see in the archways and carvings around the castle. Inside, the burnished wooden floors bear the indents from the spurs of the gentlemen's boots.

One notable event in its history is the siege by Oliver Cromwell's forces in the 17th century. During the English Civil War, Neidpath Castle served as a strategic stronghold for Royalist forces supporting King Charles I. In 1650, Cromwell's army besieged the castle, leading to a fierce struggle for control. Despite enduring significant damage from artillery fire, the defenders valiantly held out for several weeks before surrendering.

The siege left its mark on Neidpath Castle, with scars of battle visible on its walls, serving as a poignant reminder of its turbulent past. You can find a painting of the battle scene at the entrance to the Batik Room.
