The Minister introduces the Vows: Thomas and Miriam. I now invite you to join hands and make your vows, in the presence of God and his people.

The Giving of Rings

The Minister receives the rings, blesses them, and invites the couple to place them on each other's ring finger.

The Proclamation

The Minister addresses the people and proclaims the Marriage.

The Blessing of the Marriage

The husband and wife kneel, and the Minister pronounces the nuptial blessing.
