The minister says to the bride:

Bride answers:

I will.

The minister asks the parents of the bride and bridegroom: Jake and Anna have declared their intention towards each other. As their parents, will you now entrust your son and daughter to one another as they come to be married?

Both sets of parents respond: We will.

The minister says to the congregation:

Will you, the families and friends of Jake and Anna, support and uphold them in their marriage now and in the years to come?

All: We will.
