The hour I first believed!*

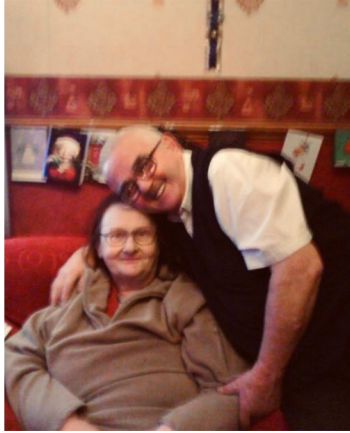
