deepen.

enfold them, today and in the years to come.

The president addresses the congregation

Will all of you support and encourage Hannah and Phil in their marriage?

**All - We will.**

## 4 The Liturgy of the Word

### READING

*A reading from Ruth 1.16-18 by Heather Strachan*

### **Hymn - Morning has Broken**

- 1. Morning has broken , like the first morning,  
blackbird has spoken, like the first bird.  
Praise for the singing! Praise for the morning!  
Praise for them, springing , fresh from the Word!**

like the first dewfall, on the first grass.

## 5. The Promises

Hannah. and Phil. face each other.  
One of them takes the other's right hand and says

-- Before God and our friends,  
I, Hannah give myself to you, Phil,  
in loving and lifelong marriage.  
I promise to be with you,  
in sorrow and in joy,  
in need and in plenty,  
in frailty and in strength.  
God keep me  
always true to this promise.

They loose hands. The other takes the first's right hand and says

-- Before God and our friends,  
I, Phil, give myself to you, Hannah,  
in loving and lifelong marriage.  
I promise to be with you,  
in sorrow and in joy,  
in need and in plenty,  
in frailty and in strength.  
God keep me  
always true to this promise.

## 6. The Giving and Receiving of Rings

Hannah and Phil face each other.

One of them places a ring on the other's finger, saying

-- Phil, I give you this ring as I give you myself, all that I have,  
and all that I am.

The other places a ring on the first's finger, saying

-- Hannah I give you this ring as I give you myself, all that I have,  
and all that I am.

## 7. The Proclamation

As Hannah and Phil continue to face each other, joining hands, the  
congregation says

**all - We have witnessed the promises of Hannah and Phil  
As they are pledged to each other in love,  
so we promise, in hope,  
to be a living sign of love in the world.**

The president says to Hannah and Phil

Hannah and Phil, now that you have made these promises  
before God and before those gathered here,  
I declare that you are joined in marriage.  
The peace of the Lord be with you.

## 8. THE PEACE

The president says to the congregation:  
We meet in Christ's name.

The congregation responds:  
**all - Let us share his peace.**
