1 Corinthians 13

If I speak in the tongues of men or of angels, but do not have love, I am only a resounding gong or a clanging cymbal. If I have the gift of prophecy and can fathom all mysteries and all knowledge, and if I have a faith that can move mountains, but do not have love, I am nothing. If I give all I possess to the poor and give over my body to hardship that I may boast, but do not have love, I gain nothing.

Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. It does not dishonour others, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres.

Love never fails. But where there are prophecies, they will cease; where there are tongues, they will be stilled; where there is knowledge, it will pass away. For we know in part and we prophesy in part, but when completeness comes, what is in part disappears. When I was a child, I talked like a child, I thought like a child, I reasoned like a child. When I became a man, I put the ways of childhood behind me. For now we see only a reflection as in a mirror; then we shall see face to face. Now I know in part; then I shall know fully, even as I am fully known.

And now these three remain: faith, hope and love. But the greatest of these is love.

THE MARRIAGE CEREMONY

Lise and Jari stand in front of the pastor, facing her.

Pastor: Are you, Lise Ann Emerson, free lawfully to marry Jari Pentti Juhani Partanen?

Lise: I am.

Pastor: Are you, Jari Pentti Juhani Partanen, free lawfully to marry Lise Ann Emerson

Jari: I am.

Pastor: So, listen to words from the Holy Scriptures about the life together of people in marriage and committed partnerships.

Bible Reading: Colossians 3:12-17

12 Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience.

13 Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you. 14 And over all these virtues put on love, which binds them all together in perfect unity.

15 Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, since as members of one body you were called to peace. And be thankful. 16 Let the message of Christ dwell among you richly as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom through psalms, hymns, and songs from the Spirit, singing to God with gratitude in your hearts. 17 And whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him.

SOLEMNISATION OF THE MARRIAGE

Pastor: The Holy Scriptures testify that marriage is a good and healing gift from God. God also desires to protect and bless your marriage.

After hearing the word of the Holy Scriptures, I ask you before God and His congregation:

Jari Pentti Juhani Partanen, do you take Lise as your wife from God's hand, to love and honour her, to share joy and sorrow with her, and to remain faithful to her until death do you part? If so, answer "I do".

Pastor: Lise Ann Emerson, do you take Jari as your husband from God's hand, to love and honour him, to share joy and sorrow with him, and to remain faithful to him until death do you part? If so, answer "I do".

Lise: I do.

EXCHANGE OF RINGS WITH VOWS

Lise and Jari now face each other. The following words are whispered to them so they can repeat them out loud themselves.

Jari: I take you, Lise, to be my wedded wife. I give you this ring as a sign of my love and faithfulness *(Jari puts the ring on Lise's finger)*.

Lise: I take you, Jari, to be my wedded husband. I give you this ring as a sign of my love and faithfulness *(Lise puts the ring on Jari's finger)*.

DECLARATION

Pastor to Lise and Jari:

Please join hands with each other *(pastor puts her hands on theirs)*.

Lise and Jari, by their promises before God and in the presence of this congregation, have bound themselves to one another as husband and wife. Those whom God has joined together let no one put asunder.

In the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit.

All: Amen.
