The Presentation of the Candidate

The Declaration of Our Faith

The minister addresses the congregation:

Let us affirm together the faith which is ours and is of the Church
throughout the world,
and which, we pray, will become Alexander's faith:

Do you believe and trust in God the Father,
source of all being and life, the one for whom we exist?

I believe and trust in Him.

Do you believe and trust in God the Son,
who took our human nature, died for us and rose again?

I believe and trust in Him.

Do you believe and trust in God the Holy Spirit,
who gives life to the people of God and makes Christ known in the world?

I believe and trust in Him.

This is the faith of the Church.

This is our faith.

The Waters of Baptism

The water is poured into the font.

The minister leads a prayer over the water saying:

We praise you, loving Father,
for the gift of your Son Jesus.
He was baptised in the River Jordan,
where your Spirit came upon him
and revealed him as the Son you love.
He sent his followers to baptise all who turn to him.
Now Father, we ask you to bless this water,
that Alexander who is to be baptised in it
