The Trafalgar Tavern was built in 1837, the year Queen Victoria ascended the throne. It was frequented by Charles Dickens, who chose the Tavern as the setting for the wedding breakfast in Our Mutual Friend, his final novel. It was around the same time that politicians decided to host ministerial 'whitebait dinners' here, dining on whitebait caught fresh from the Thames. This became an annual tradition for ministers, who would travel across from Westminster to the Tavern by barge.
