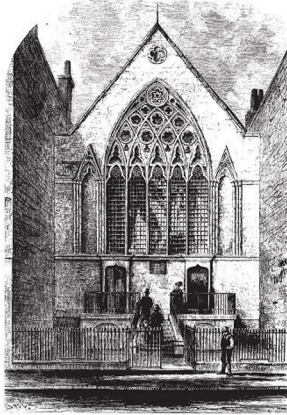

The Church of St. Etheldreda's

St. Etheldreda's was the town chapel of the Bishop of Ely from about 1250 to 1570. It is the oldest Catholic church in England and one of only two remaining buildings in London from the reign of Edward I.

The church has had many uses over the centuries, including as a prison and as a hospital for soldiers during the Civil War. In 1531, Henry VIII held a banquet here, which lasted for five days. In 1576, Sir Christopher Hatton, a favourite with Queen Elizabeth I, took an interest in the lands surrounding the chapel of St. Etheldreda's, wanting to use them to build a new palace with spacious gardens. Bishop Cox refused to grant Sir Christopher a lease and so received a letter from Elizabeth I.

Shortly thereafter, Sir Christopher was granted his lease in return for £10, a few bales of hay and one red rose per year.

The church was purchased at auction in 1873 by the Institute of Charity (Rosminian Fathers), who still serve St. Etheldreda's today.
