Refrain:

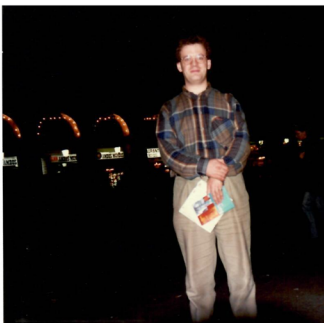
Thine be the glory, risen, conqu'ring Son;

7 The Lord shall preserve thee from all evil: he shall preserve thy soul.

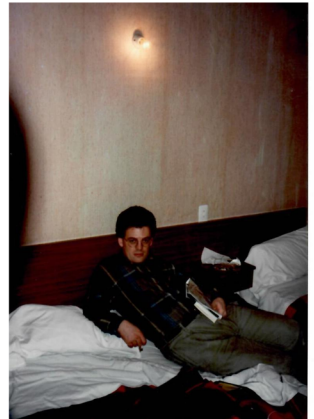
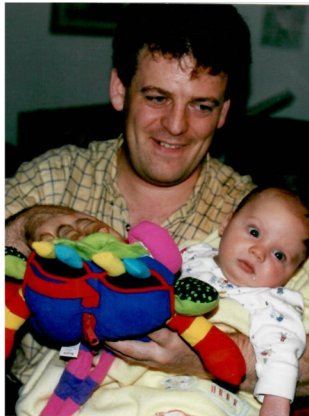
