Rage, rage against the dying of the light.*

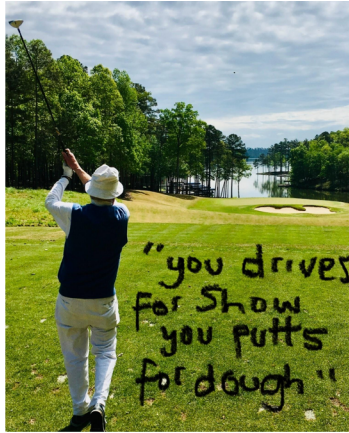
*Wild men who caught and sang the sun in flight,
