### **THE DECISION**

Parents and Godparents please stand

In baptism, God calls us out of darkness into his marvellous light. To follow Christ means dying to sin and rising to new life with him.

Therefore I ask:

Do you reject the devil and all rebellion against God?

**I reject them.**

Do you renounce the deceit and corruption of evil?

**I renounce them.**

Do you repent of the sins that separate us from God and neighbour?

**I repent of them.**

Do you turn to Christ as Saviour?

**I turn to Christ.**

Do you submit to Christ as Lord?

**I submit to Christ.**

Do you come to Christ, the way, the truth and the life?

**I come to Christ.**

### **SIGNING WITH THE CROSS**

Christ claims you for his own. Receive the sign of his cross. Do not be ashamed to confess the faith of Christ crucified.

**All: Fight valiantly as a disciple of Christ  
against sin, the world and the devil,  
and remain faithful to Christ to the end of your life.**

May almighty God deliver you from the powers of darkness, restore in you the image of his glory, and lead you in the light and obedience of Christ.

**All: Amen.**

**READING: John Chapter 6, Verses 35-40**

### **ADDRESS**

Parents and Godparents go to the font

Praise God who made heaven and earth,  
**All: Who keeps his promise for ever.**

Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.  
**All: It is right to give thanks and praise.**

### **PRAYER OVER THE WATER**

Brothers and sisters, I ask you to profess together with parents and godparents the faith of the Church.

Do you believe and trust in God the Father?

**All: I believe in God, the Father almighty,  
creator of heaven and earth.**

Do you believe and trust in his Son Jesus Christ?

**All: I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord, who was  
conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary,  
suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was  
buried; he descended to the dead. On the third day he rose  
again; he ascended into heaven, he is seated at the right hand  
of the Father, and he will come to judge the living and the  
dead.**

Do you believe and trust in the Holy Spirit?

**All: I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the  
communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection  
of the body and the life everlasting. Amen.**

## **BAPTISM**

Maxwell, I baptize you in the name of the Father, and of the Son,  
and of the Holy Spirit.

**All: Amen.**

There is one Lord, one faith, one baptism:

Maxwell, by one Spirit we are all baptized into one body.

**All: We welcome you into the fellowship of faith; we are  
children of the same heavenly Father; we welcome you.**

The peace of the Lord be always with you

**All: and also with you.**

## **GIVING OF CANDLE**

You have received the light of Christ;

**All: Shine as a light in the world to the glory of God the Father.**
