We would also like to thank those who helped us care for her over the last few years, and who were such an amazing support to us over the last few months when mum was really poorly.

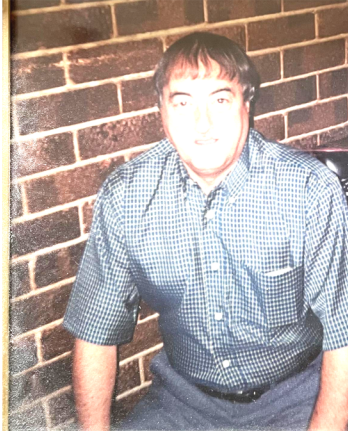
