You have brought new life to mankind.

Blessed are you, Holy Spirit of God.

You bring us together in love.

Blessed be the Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

One God, to be praised for ever. Amen.

THE LORD'S PRAYER

All:

Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name, thy kingdom come, thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us.

And lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil. For thine is the kingdom, the power, and the glory for ever and ever.
