#### *Directions*

*Leave the crematorium and re-join Bayswater Road (the road from the A40 roundabout). Turn left and head north for approx 1 mile. Turn left on to B 4027, then after only 0.1 mile, head slightly right on New Inn Road. Go along this road for 0.8 mile until you meet Beckley High Street; here, turn right and the pub will soon appear on the left hand side.*
