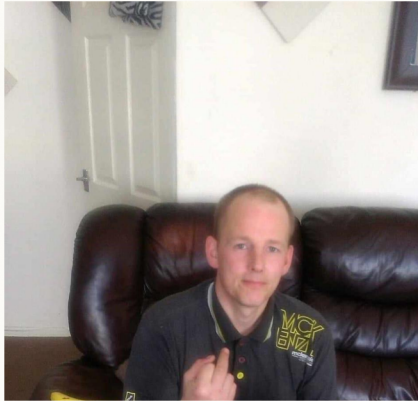
Our father,
