#### **1 CORINTHIANS 13/ 1 KORINTHIERS 13**

If I speak in the tongues of men or of angels, but do not have love,

I am only a resounding gong or a clanging cymbal.

*Nou wys ek julle wat nog die allerbeste is; Al praat ek die tale van mense en engele,  
maar ek het geen liefde nie,*

*Het ek n stuk klinkende metaal, 'n galmende simbaal geword,*

If I have the gift of prophecy and can fathom all mysteries and all knowledge,  
and if I have a faith that can move mountains, but do not have love, I am nothing.

*Al het ek die gave van profesie en ken al die geheimenisse en besit al die kennis,  
En al het al die geloof om berge te versit, maar ek het geen liefde nie, dan is ek niks.*

If I give all I possess to the poor and give over my body to hardship that I may  
boast, but do not have love, I gain nothing.

Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud.  
*Die liefde is geduldig, die liefde is vriendelik, Dit is nie afgunstig nie, is nie grootprutig nie, is nie verwaard nie.*

It does not dishonor others, it is not self-seeking,  
it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs.
