You are here because he meant something to you. Maybe, you even loved him

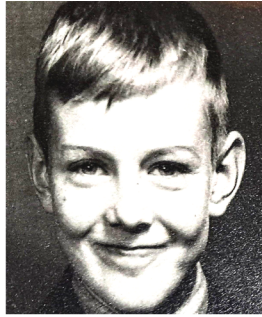
And that means a great deal to us
