*Thanks to me we have an idyllic cottage by the sea*

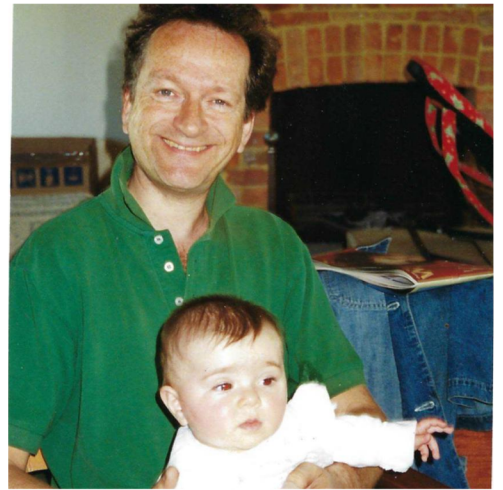
*I adore my stepsons and know they love me*
